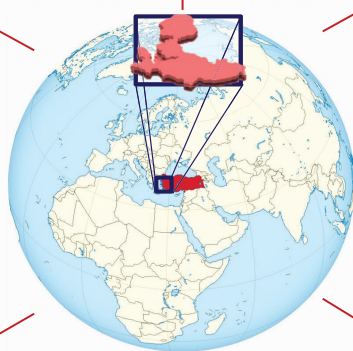


POWER OF İZMİR
