Dear Colleagues,

The NATO Defence Innovation Accelerator for the North Atlantic (DIANA), is a NATO body with a mission to accelerate the development and adoption of dual-use technologies to solve critical defence and security challenges across the NATO Alliance.

NATO DIANA delivers on this mission through launching public challenge calls, with 'challenge statements' setting out problems to be solved and objectives to be achieved. Companies, often with limited experience within the defence sector, submit proposals setting out how their solutions can solve key themes within these challenges. After a rigorous competitive selection process, the successful companies are brought into DIANA's 'Challenge Programme' and attend DIANA's 'Accelerator Programme'. As part of the programme, companies prepare for selling to the defence industry and engage in dialogues with end users. Companies also have the opportunity to undertake testing, evaluation, verification and validation activities, and engage in operational experiments and exercises, all aimed at facilitating adoption by Allied end users.

To ensure DIANA's challenges represent NATO and Allied capability needs and priorities, and to accurately communicate demand signals to the market, DIANA is seeking your inputs on current and future capability needs. DIANA will analyse the inputs you provide through this 'challenge formation process', as it creates future Challenge Programmes and drafts the challenge statements that are published to the market.

We kindly invite you to contribute your current and future capability needs by completing the linked form before 28 of January 2026. If you have existing materials setting out future capability needs, problem statements, or other relevant content, you need not "re-type" this material into the form. Rather, this information can be shared with us directly at challenges@diana.nato.int. We still suggest that you fill out relevant portions of the form regarding other elements, such as events and contacts, so that we can capture all the relevant information. Please note in form section B 'Capability Needs Inputs' that information is being sent separately.

If you would be willing to support DIANA's challenge call by acting as an evaluator and/or by engaging with selected innovators and their solutions once they are brought into the Challenge Programme, your expertise and engagement would be highly valued.
